- Ensuring the safety and comfort of patrons by keeping aware at all times of issues of safety and emergency procedures, especially when seating latecomers in the dark.
- Supporting the Front of House volunteer staff by helping the FOH Manager ensure directions are being communicated and acted out on shift.

The successful candidate for this position will possess:

- Excellent verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills
- Proven organizational and time management abilities
- An outgoing, friendly personality
- A strong attention to detail and awareness of safety
- A passion for and knowledge of theatre, arts and culture
- Evening/weekend availability
