## What is a Jane's Walk?

Jane's Walks are free, locally organized walking tours, in which people get together to explore, talk about and celebrate their neighbourhoods. Named after Jane Jacobs, an American-Canadian author and activist best known for her seminal work in urban studies, the walks take place around the world, usually close to Jane Jacob's birthday on May 4<sup>th</sup>. This year, Jane's Walk will take place May 4<sup>th</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

A Jane's Walk can focus on almost any aspect of a neighbourhood, and on almost any topic you can think of. Walks can be serious or funny, informative or exploratory. They can look at the history of a place, or at what's happening there right now. Anyone can lead a walk because everyone is an expert on the place where they live!

This year, 10-Minute Plays will invite six local companies to research, create and present a ten minute play focusing on Calgary's core and performed on Stephen Avenue. Stephen Avenue inspires reflection on what it means to be a city andwhat it means to be the core of a city. Potential themes are many. What does this patch of land mean in the historic and contemporary context of Treaty 7? What does its architecture say? What historic figures are remembered on this street? What does it mean to office workers on their lunch break or theatregoers on a Saturday night?

Selected companies will present their plays in succession along Stephen Avenue the weekend of May 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, as part of Calgary's celebration of the international *Jane's Walk* weekend.
